Games began June 18 and will continue through July 26, with 684 teams playing in fields across Alpharetta, Atlanta, Canton, Kennesaw, Mableton, Marietta, Roswell, Smyrna, and Woodstock.

“The players get to play in front of 500-600 college coaches and scouts at the 17u and 18u WWBA, and the 16u, to some extent. The younger age divisions are popular because it is a very well run event with

very good teams from across the country. All of the players are members of summer travel teams. The travel teams are comprised of top level players from several different high schools in their area. Several of the very top picks of each year's draft participate in these tournaments each year," says Perfect Game USA National Tournament Director, Taylor McCollough.
